

Typical Week in Nightingale Class





As we are a Year 1 class, we start every day with daily phonics lessons. The children have access to continuous provision throughout the day and complete their academic work in small groups supported by an adult.

Monday

On Mondays, we introduce the weekly spellings pattern. We then have our maths lesson which is often a practical lesson to help support the learning. In the afternoon we have Topic and Computing. The children rotate between their activity and accessing the continuous provision.

Tuesday

On Tuesdays, we start with our maths lesson, followed by our grammar lesson to help develop our writing skills. In the afternoon we have PE, Music and PSHE.

Wednesday

On Wednesdays, we start our weekly 'big write' which gives us an opportunity to put our spelling and grammar learning into a piece of fiction or non-fiction writing. After play time we have a maths lesson and, in the afternoon, we have science and geography.

Thursday

On Thursdays, we have a chance to finish off our 'big write'. We then have PE later in the morning. In the afternoon we have RE and continuous provision.

Friday

On Fridays, we have maths, followed by our reading lesson. This is where we develop our comprehension skills to support our reading. In the afternoon we have art. To finish the week, we enjoy our half an hour golden time activity before our weekly Celebration Assembly.
