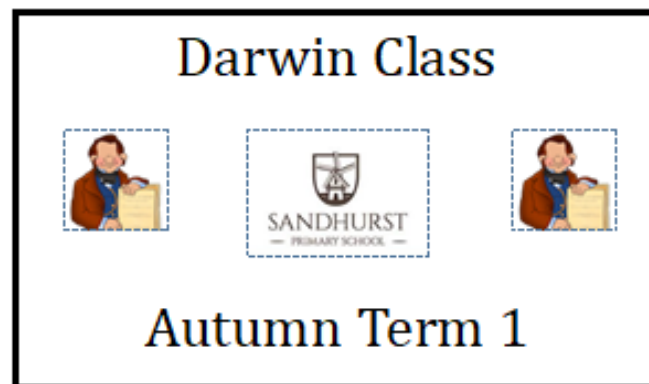

Grammar

- Introduction of nouns

- Conjunctions being used such as and, or, but
- Introduce question and marks exclamation marks to determine commands and exclamations

Punctuation

- Reading sentences allowed to check they make sense with the chosen punctuation
- Begin to use and understand question marks
