Challah bread

A braided loaf eaten on the Sabbath and during Jewish holidays.

Havdalah candle

The candle which is lit at a service held at home to say goodbye to the Shabbat.

Kiddush cup

A cup filled with wine and used as a blessing at the beginning of a meal at a Jewish festival or on Shabbat.

A day of rest which starts at sunset on Friday and ends at sunset on Saturday.

The five books of Moses that state the laws Jews must follow.
